- **Other Best out of Waste Products** : Scrunchies , Electric Lamp, Key Rings , Bangle Box etc.

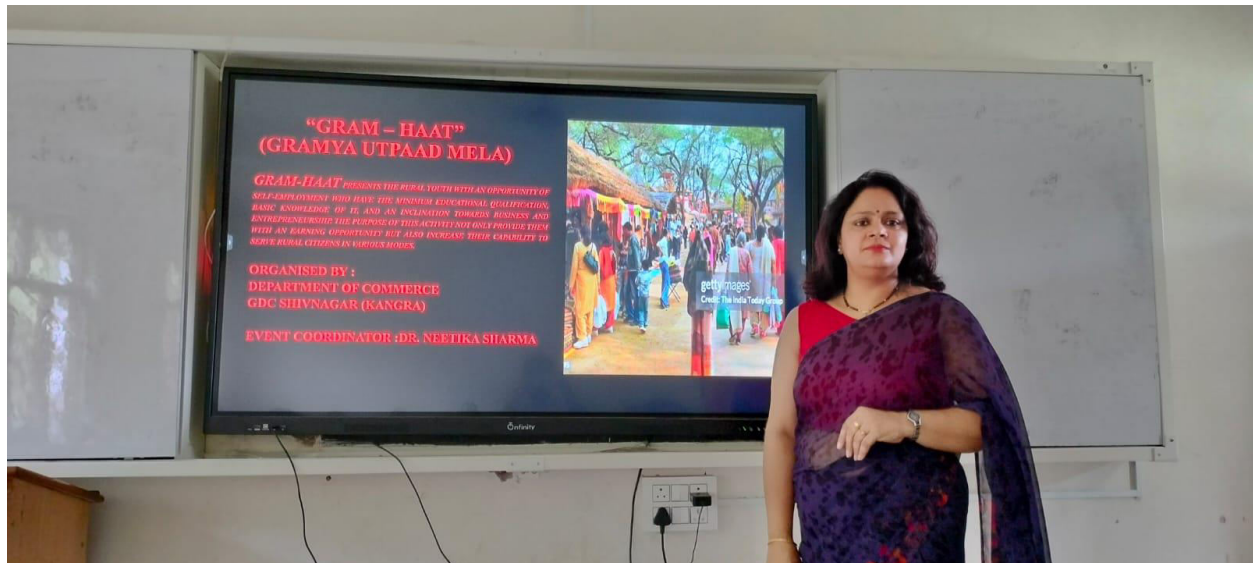
Achievements:
